

CREATIVE WATERCOLOR

Supply list: (Suggested by instructor but students may use their own selection.)

Tube watercolors:

Cadmium, yellow pale
Cadmium, Orange
Indian Red
Cadmium Red or Winsor Red
*Opera (Holbein)
Raw Sienna
Burnt Sienna
Cobalt Turquoise
Winsor (thalo) blue
Ivory black
*Blue grey (Holbein)

*Hard to find colors. Instructor may have some extra.

Brushes:

Round No. 3 and No. 8 (small and medium)
Aquarielle or flat long bristle, ½ and 1 inch

Paper:

140 lb. Rough Arches, 22x30 inches. Clamp or tack to stiff support
Half and quarter sheets can be used. Cut to 15x22 or 11x15
If serious watercolorist, use an Arches block, 140 lb. Rough, 18x24 inches, or
12x16. No board is needed with the block.

Miscellaneous:

Hard drawing pencil
Ultra fine point Sharpie permanent marker
Kneaded eraser
Plastic palette (square for paint, larger shallow wells for mixing)
Plastic bucket or jar with water (your choice)
Rag (piece of old towel works great)
